READINGS FOR 3<sup>RD</sup> SUNDAY OF ADVENT

First Reading: Penned around 530 BC in the midst of the difficulties in the re-building of Jerusalem after the 60-year exile, the prophet announces that the Almighty's plan was now entering a new phase: a time of prosperity, liberty and freedom, when 'the Lord will make (the Chosen People's) integrity and praise spring up in the sight of the nations.' This spirit of hope was passed down and was the one in which Mary received our Saviour. **Second Reading:** Today's reading comes at the conclusion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> of St Paul's earliest letters written around 51 AD. The brief instruction given here has had enormous influence on Christian spirituality. The gift of the Spirit is a feature of the messianic era and discernment of its inspirations is one of its gifts. Mention of the body, soul and spirit serves to underline 'the totality of the sanctifying action of God.'

**Gospel:** Like John the Baptist we each have a role as a 'Christ-bearer'. (Glenstal Missal) We are called to turn our lives into a pointer to our Saviour, living his hidden life among men. This self-effacing task should not be underrated: it is a kind of preparatory baptism' (like John's) for those whom God has called to be new people
