Readings for 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B

First Reading: The time is about 1040 BC. In the silent watches of the night the young Samuel hears his name called. The child's willing response would go on to change the history of Israel and of the world. Samuel anointed the great king David.

Second Reading: Corinth was a port city of Greece and given to depravity and licentiousness. St Paul entreats his new converts to remember that for them life has been changed utterly. 'Anyone who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with him....Your body, you know, is the temple of the Holy Spirit..... You have been bought and paid for.'

Gospel: The transition from the old to the new covenant with Mankind is made at this juncture when John the Baptist guides his closest disciples (including probably the young St John the evangelist himself) to Jesus, the anointed one, 'the lamb of God.' They receive the great invitation: 'Come and see.' Their eager response is like the young Samuel's of 1000 years before and the response of Christians ever since.
