TRÓCAIRE LENTEN CAMPAIGN 2021

First Sunday of Lent

This Lent, Trócaire is highlighting the impact of conflict on families living in South Sudan. We see how neighbours support each other and work together through hard times to survive and thrive. You can show your care by supporting them and praying for them.

Awut and Ajak are two remarkable women who are survivors. They survived a war, but each day remains a battle: a battle to earn money; a battle to grow food; a battle to pay for their children's school; a battle to survive and thrive. They both lost their homes and loved ones to the conflict in South Sudan. They fled their villages with nothing but the clothes on their back, trekking through miles of dangerous bushland with no food or water for themselves or their children. They found help in the community of Malek, where people whose lives were brought together by pain and suffering are starting new lives based on love, friendship and kindness. Every day remains a struggle for Awut and Ajak and their families, but they face these challenges together, with dignity and solidarity.

Trócaire works with local partners in South Sudan. Their programmes in South Sudan support communities and families in the following ways: Emergency aid such as food, water and sanitation and hygiene items; Seeds, tools and agricultural training to help people grow their own food; counselling support to help people overcome the trauma they have experienced; promoting peaceful coexistence between all the people of South Sudan.

Father James Oyet Latansio, the General Secretary of the South Sudan Council of Churches, wrote the following prayer for peace to be said during Lent 2021:

Praver for Peace

As we move through the Lenten time, the time when we contemplate Jesus in the desert, pray for us the people of South Sudan and pray for peace here. Accompany us, hold our hands, hold the hands of the Church in South Sudan. Hold the hands of our brothers and sisters in South Sudan, walk with us during this Lenten time. Through Christ our Lord, Amen.

Reading: Even all those thousands of years ago the rainbow was interpreted as a sign that the plan of Mankind's ultimate salvation had been laid down. In fact the New Testament would reveal that 'God wished to share with us divine benefits which entirely surpass the powers of the human mind to understand.' (1st Vatican Council, and quoted in 2nd Vat Council 'Dei Verbum' 6). In today's gospel the curtain for that revelation goes up. Second Reading: The corrupt contemporaries of Noah rejected the promptings of the Holy Spirit and the Flood waters were sent to cleanse the earth. So too the waters of baptism offer each of us the chance to sincerely purge ourselves of evil and commit ourselves to the victorious Christ, who sits at God's right hand. Gospel: Immediately after his baptism Jesus is driven (forcefully) by the Holy Spirit into the desert. The desert for Jesus, as it was for the Israelites during their 40 years in the desert with Moses, is a kind of runway, a preparation. Jesus emerges from it to announce to the world in both word and deed: 'The time has come, and the kingdom of God is close at hand. Repent and believe the Good News.'
