CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK

Sunday, 24 January, marks the beginning of Catholic Schools Week 2021. During this week we aim to celebrate the unique contribution that Catholic schools, both primary and post-primary, make to supporting each other and living out Jesus' message of the gospel. This year's theme is 'Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith and Resilience'.

We are blessed to have two Catholic primary schools in our parish and in order to celebrate the immense contribution they make to this parish, and to the wider community, Mass on Thurs 28th January at 10am will be offered for the staff and pupils of the St Mura's NS and St Aengus' NS. You, your families and our young people are encouraged to watch this Mass online and join in praying for all members of our school communities, especially in these difficult times.

READINGS FOR 3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: The book dates from around 350 BC and is a high point of Old Testament theology. It is intended both to amuse and instruct. It rejects a too rigid interpretation of prophecy. Even God's heaviest threat to punish is an expression of his merciful will towards all mankind. He pardons at the first sign of repentance.

Second reading: 'We must watch lest we become ensnared with a world which is passing.' St Paul overlays and enriches our care for people and everyday affairs with the fact "that the time has now become limited." (Literally: 'time has been put under full sail.' Christ is now present among us.

Gospel: Jesus' good news of the arrival of the kingdom of God on earth involves repentance, similar to what the story of Jonah called for. But with Jesus the Kingdom is not just coming, it has actually arrived. The disciples and Apostles have the job of rolling the 'Gospel' out to the whole world.
