All the dynamics of a family are in<br>play, even with an obstinate, atheistic and downright hostile world. 'And yet, Lord, you<br>are our Father, we the clay, you the potter, we are all the work of your hand.'<br><b>Second Reading:</b> Paul is very affectionate towards his converts in Corinth, who had<br>come mostly from among the poor. In this short reading he commends the teachers<br>among them who have helped them become strong in the Spirit and united in Jesus<br>Christ.
