Readings for 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Deuteronomy chapter 18 is interesting. Moses tells the Israelites that the reason the Lord assisted them in driving out the original inhabitants of the Promised Land was the pagans' devotion to false Gods and superstition. He goes to reassure them that for his own people God would raise up another Israelite prophet like Moses himself to guide them with authority in all truth. They must listen to him.

Reading: St Paul at this time considered that Jesus' return was imminent. Therefore his overriding concern was that his Christian converts should cultivate an undivided heart in seeking God's will. The theme is a continuation of last Sunday's.

Gospel: The time of the promised new Moses has at last come. But, beyond all expectations, God has given us the very Word of God himself, God's full revelation of himself. Unlike a normal scribe who relied on accepted authorities Jesus spoke to the synagogue on his own authority. He himself in his own person is the image and revelation of the nature of God. That revelation was completed on the Cross.
